

## MobilePass Newsletter #4 February 2017



## MobilePass Demonstration - The successful test of a fully new concept for mobile border crossing process


The MobilePass Consortium is happy to report a very successful demonstration at the land border in Sculeni/Romania. For 4 days a team of more than 20 specialists operated an innovative mobile system for a full-page check of electronic passports, biometric facial and contactless fingerprint verification. Statistical feedback from travellers as well as from border guards for this novel and EU regulations compliant procedure is available. You can see below some highlights of these outcomes.
